

OPTIONAL 3-DAY EXTENSION March 11 – 13, 2016

Hotel for night 12: Jerusalem

Day 13: Friday, March 11: Negev

- In the morning we'll visit an "unrecognized" Bedouin village in the Negev, meet the residents and have lunch hosted by a Bedouin family.
- We'll spend the afternoon on a nature walk in the Ein Avdat canyon, where numerous springs empty into deep pools and a series of waterfalls.
- Continuing south, we'll stop at the visitor center at Mitzpe Ramon to take in the magnificent view of the "Grand Canyon of Israel."
- Arriving at Kibbutz Lotan, a Reform Jewish community, we'll have the opportunity either to attend their Shabbat service or rest up after a long day, and then enjoy Shabbat dinner with the kibbutzniks.

Day 14: Saturday, March 12: Petra

- We'll cross the border into Jordan where we'll meet our Jordanian guide,
- Then make our way to Petra where we'll spend the rest of the day exploring this remarkable ancient Nabataean city carved into the rock of the desert.
- We'll have dinner together in Petra.

Hotel: Petra (B & D)

Day 15: Sunday, March 13: Return Home

- We'll drive back to the border and.
- After crossing into Israel, we'll fly from Eilat to Tel Aviv to catch our flights back home.
