Birmingham Temple Petra Extension

Discover Jordan's many treasures with this Petra extension, the perfect addition to a trip in Israel and Palestine. Walk down the narrow canyon, "Siq", before reaching the Treasury, one of Petra's most iconic images. Continue on this path to explore Petra's ancient buildings and tombs carved into the red-rose cliffs.

Pre-trip Day 1: Fri. June 10th – Departure from Detroit

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Pre-trip Day 2: Sat. June 11th – Arrival into Amman

Arrive at Queen Alia International Airport, and transfer to our hotel in Amman, Jordan.

Hotel: Grand Palace Amman (D)

Pre-trip Day 3: Sun. June 12th – Petra

Start the day early, driving south from Amman to Petra. Spend the rest of the day exploring Petra, the legendary city of the Nabataean people. Hidden in deep canyons south of the Dead Sea, this remarkable site was founded more than 2,400 years ago. Enter the ancient city through its primary entrance known as the Siq, a narrow chasm between naturally sculpted cliffs. This passageway, which could have been easily defended against attack by an invading army, ends at the glorious sight of the world-famous Treasury. Go on a guided visit of the expansive site, where hundreds of monuments were rediscovered only in 1812. Then enjoy time on your own to explore the Royal Tombs or the Monastery. Return to our hotel at Petra, located just a few steps from this UNESCO World Heritage site.

Hotel: Petra Moon (B, D)

Pre-trip Day 4: Mon. June 13th – Transfer to Jerusalem

Check-out of our hotel in the morning. Drive north to the Allenby border crossing and cross into Israel. Drive to our hotel in Jerusalem, where you will meet up with the rest of the group for the main trip.

Hotel: Jerusalem (B, L, D)
