Itinerary:

Day 1: Wednesday, September 29, 2021 – Arrival into Amman

- After breakfast, transfer by land from Ein Gedi to Amman
- Amman City Tour
- Lunch on own
- Check into hotel

Hotel: Amman - Grand Palace (D)

Day 2: Thursday, September 30, 2021 – Travel South

- Start the day early, visiting the historical citadel and the ancient Roman theater in Amman.
- Then start the drive south from Amman to Petra along the picturesque King Highway. Have an included lunch. Make stops along the way at Madaba, Mt. Nebo, and Kerak before arriving at your hotel for check-in.
- This evening, have dinner at your hotel.

Hotel: Hyatt Hotel, Petra (B, L, D)

Day 3: Friday, October 1, 2021 – Petra

- Spend the day exploring Petra, the legendary city of the Nabataean people. Hidden in deep canyons south of the Dead Sea, this remarkable site was founded more than 2,400 years ago. Enter the ancient city through its primary entrance known as the Siq, a narrow chasm between naturally sculpted cliffs. This passageway, which could have been easily defended against attack by an invading army, ends at the glorious sight of the world-famous Treasury. Go on a guided visit of the expansive site, where hundreds of monuments were rediscovered only in 1812. Then enjoy time on your own to explore the Royal Tombs or the Monastery.
- Return to your hotel at your leisure. Dinner is included in your hotel this evening.

Hotel: Hyatt Hotel, Petra (B, D)

Day 4: Saturday, October 2, 2021 - Transfer to Tel Aviv

- Check-out of your hotel in the morning, and drive south.
- Explore Wadi Rum with a 4x4 jeep tour.
- Then continue south to the Arava border crossing and cross into Israel.
- Transfer to the Eilat airport for a short flight from Eilat to Tel Aviv.
