Itinerary:

Day 1: Monday, September 12, 2022: Tel Aviv (MEJDI Rep, 2 Guides, No Bus)

- Estimated arrival, early afternoon + airport transfer to hotel on your own (VIP service optional, at additional cost) + **covid testing (if required)**
- Programming starts with buffet dinner at 7:00pm at the hotel (including 2-4 alumni/staff)
- 8:00pm **Group orientation**

Day 2: Tuesday, September 13, 2022: Tel Aviv to Jerusalem

- Breakfast buffet in the hotel
- Walking tour of Tel Aviv, Carmel Market, and the historic port town of Jaffa end in the new Jaffa port
- Group Lunch in Jaffa
- Depart for **Sderot**
- Meeting with alumni in Sderot and a panel discussion in the shelter/playground
- Dinner and high-level Cultural event (TBD)
